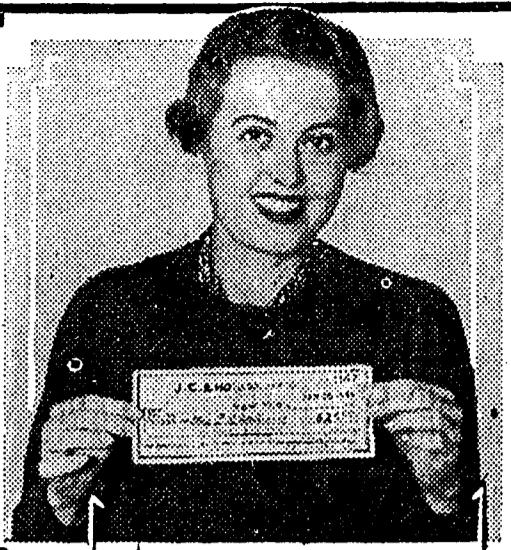
The main event is supported by an all-star card which will give the fans plenty of action and possibly something to talk about in future years to come.

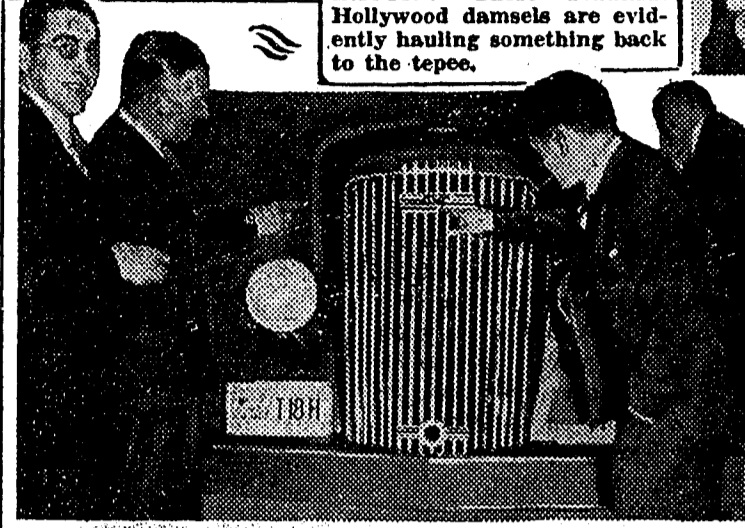

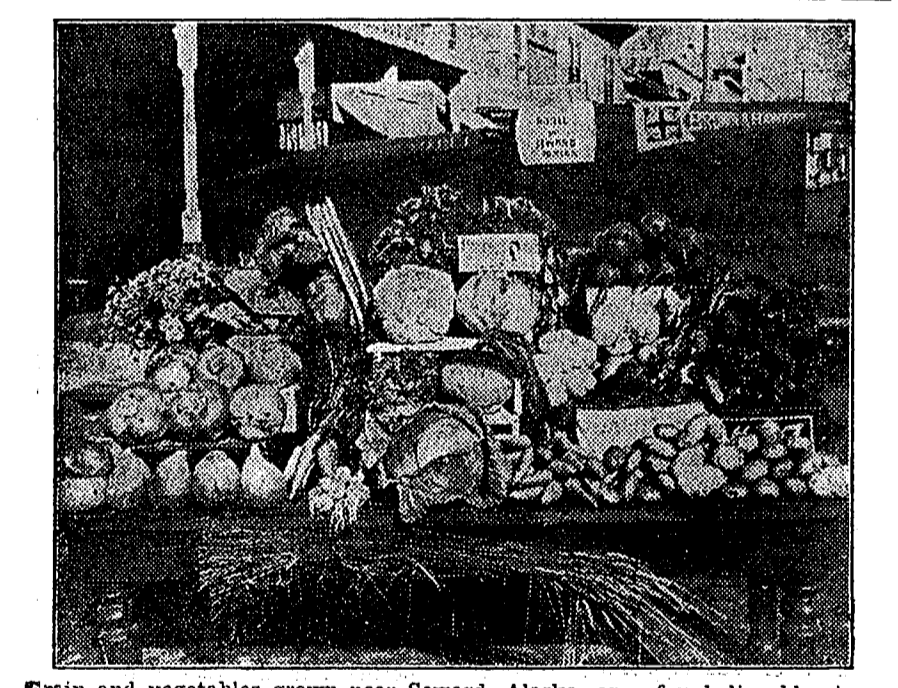
