**F&G PLANS FOCUS ON WILDLIFE AREAS**

The first draft of a long-range plan designed to promote efficient management of wildlife areas owned by the Department of Fish and Game has recently been completed. Department wildlife land managers from around the state met in Jerome to review the plan for 37 designated wildlife management and public fishing areas. The management area plans are the third volume of the 15-year plan designed to provide clear policies and strategies to guide the department. The first volume details the goals, objectives and policies of the department and is being printed. The second volume involves fish and wildlife populations and habitat

Or have you ever heard a parent say this to a frustrated and angry child? "I don't care what you think son. Your father and I love you, and we're doing what's right for you."

Family members can and should encourage each other. When we show each other our love, it is easier to throw away defenses. Sometimes, just a pat on the shoulder can let a discouraged person know you are with him.

in the state. The long-range wildlife management area plans will be directed at four major uses: —Preservation and improvement of habitat for production and maintenance of wildlife and fish; —Public hunting and fishing opportunity and harvest; —Nonconsumptive wildlife and fish uses including observation, educational and scientific study; and —Scientific, educational, recreational and other uses not related to fish and wildlife.

Gene deReus, state wildlife land manager, said the draft plan was developed for McArthur Lake Wildlife Management Area which will stress increasing the Canada goose population by creating a quality brook trout fishery.

Future plans will be tailored for each wildlife area by the regional land managers and land project leaders. The goals and objectives of each wildlife area will be set, then plans to meet these goals and objectives and dovetailed with regional and state plans. DeReus also said the public will be asked to comment before plans are presented to the fish and Game commission for approval.

**VALUE OF UNPEELED SPUDS SHOWN IN VITAMIN STUDY**

That intriguing "something extra" which makes baked potatoes different from other potato dishes probably has nothing to do with vitamin content.

Potatoes retain most of their vitamins after being baked in a conventional oven for a full hour—and vitamin retention is even better when potatoes are cooked for a shorter time in a microwave oven. But, for maximum protection of vitamins, boiling spuds with their jackets on is usually the best method of all.

How vitamin content of potatoes is affected by cooking methods was studied by U/I researchers in cooperation with scientists in Maine, N. Dakota, Minnesota and California.

In their report, the researchers said microwave ovens will cook a single potato quickly, with hardly any loss of vitamins. When several potatoes are to be cooked, microwave ovens require a longer cooking time and vitamin content is reduced. For large batches, the cooking method found to be most kind to vitamins was boiling the potatoes with the skins intact.

Unpeeled potatoes, retained vitamins well, in all tests. Vitamin losses were high in potatoes that had been peeled and quartered before boiling.

"Potatoes are a good dietary source of many nutrients. More than 70 percent of the water-soluble vitamins will be retained during home preparation of potatoes, provided the tubers are not cut prior to cooking and are consumed without delay after cooking," said Dr. Jorg Augustin, U/I biochemist.

Mashed potatoes that are kept for one hour at room temperature will retain only 40 percent of their vitamins, Augustin pointed out.

Vitamins studied in the project included ascorbic acid, thiamin, riboflavin, niacin, vitamin B-6 and follic acid.

Augustin and his colleagues are reporting their findings in an article prepared for a scientific journal.



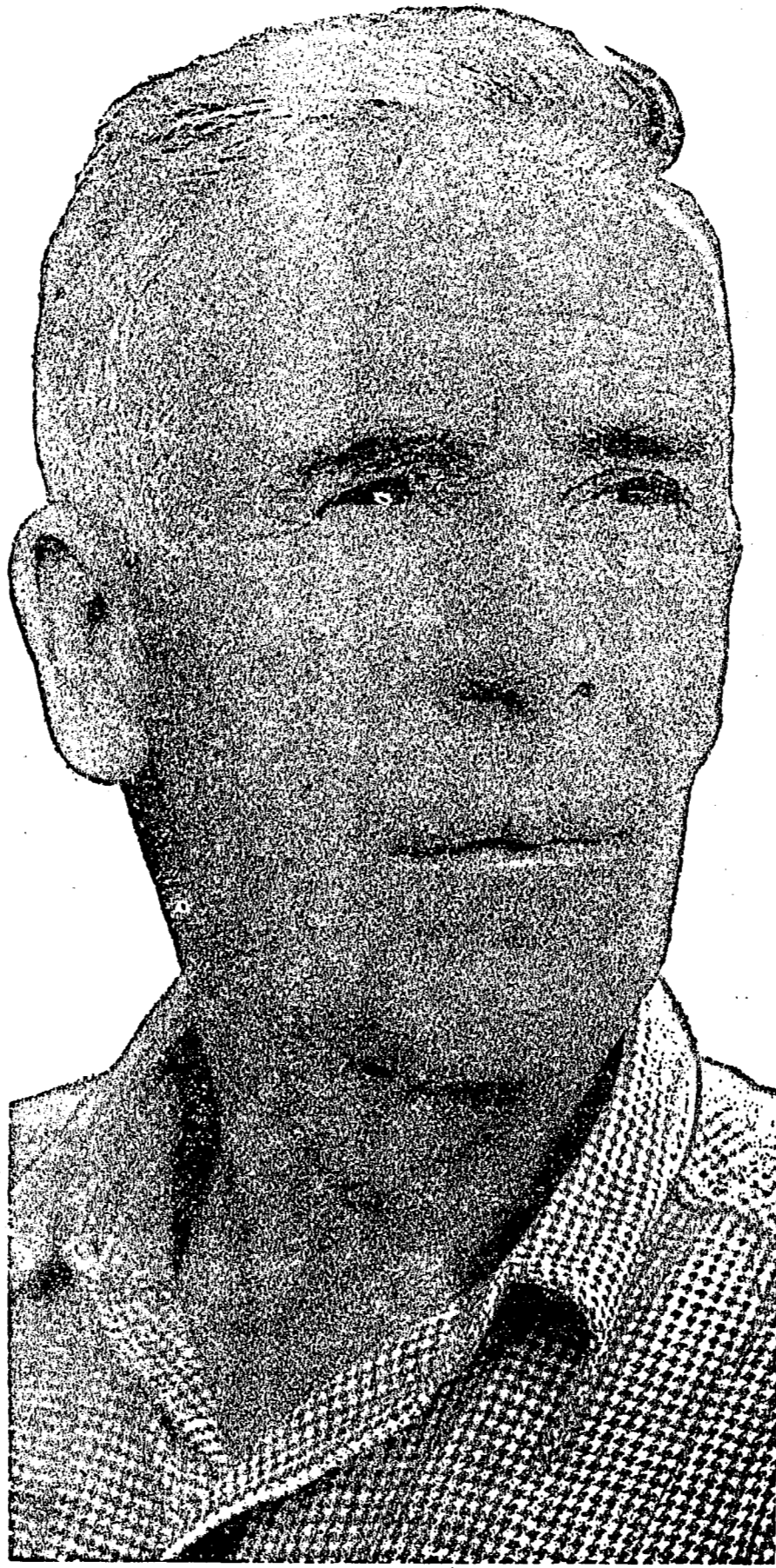

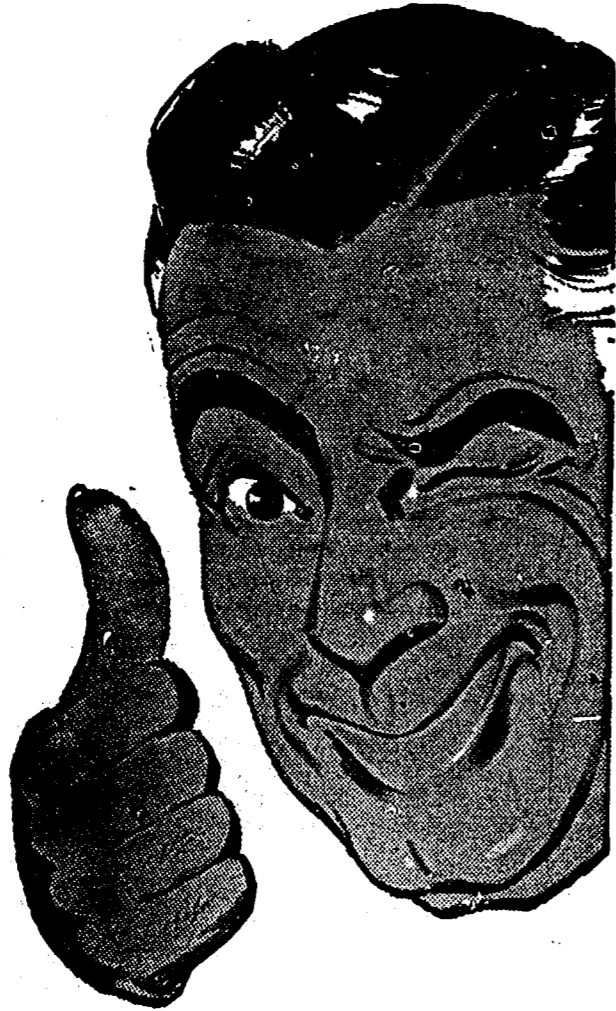
