





**GOD HUNTING INCLUDES PROPER GAME MEAT CARE**

The value of a hunting trip can result in a big zero if the proper care of meat in the field is neglected, says a Department of Fish and Game information sheet prepared for deer and elk hunters. For example:

After the game has been tagged and dressed out—elk hunters should

carry a saw or hatchet, a knife, meat sacks and a rope—the most important thing to do is cool the carcass and let the meat "set" before transporting it.

With elk and other big game, it is essential to get the carcass off the ground to allow proper cooling. Best method with an elk is to quarter the animal, hang it in a tree or use logs

brush and rocks to elevate the carcass allowing air to circulate around it.

Overnight temperatures in September and October are low enough to cool an elk that has been split and elevated. A big game animal should never be allowed to lie on the ground for more than a few hours, even in subfreezing weather.

Protect meat from flies by covering quarters with meat sacks. Fly eggs can be easily removed by cutting off the affected portion with a knife.

And remember to comply with regulations—evidence of sex must remain attached to the carcass in any antlered or antlerless-only hunt.
