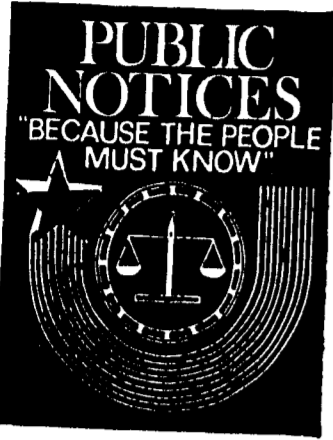

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GENESSEE, IDAHO:

(A) LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (R): Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter (NE¼ NE¼) of Section Fifteen (15), Township Thirty-Seven (37) Nor-

Commencing at the intersections of the centerlines of Fir Street and Oak Avenue, thence East along the centerline of Oak Avenue to the eastern boundary of Section Fourteen (14) thence South along said section line three hundred and sixty (360) feet to the southern boundary of Willow Street, thence West one thousand five hundred and forty five and sixty-four one hundredths (1545.64) feet along said southern boundary to a point, thence South 63° 44' West for two hundred and ten and fifteen one hundredths (210.15) feet to a point, thence continuing along the centerline of Cow Creek South 59° 15' West for one hundred forty-six and eleven one-hundredths (146.11) feet more or less, thence departing from the centerline of Cow Creek and running North along the centerline of Fir Street to the point of beginning.

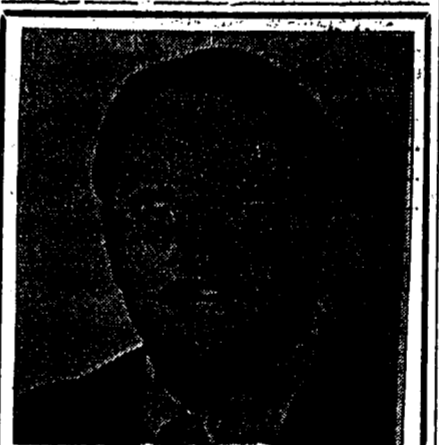

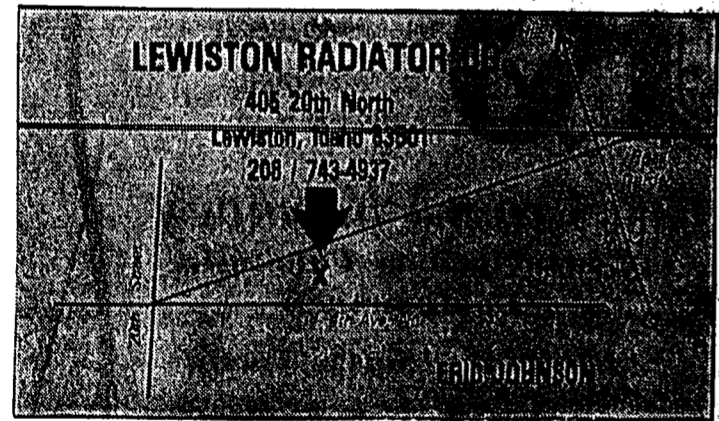
