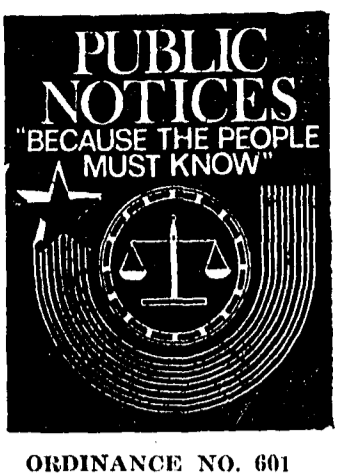

Homes Sought For Brazilian Students
Homes are being sought in Genesee, Kendrick and Juliaetta for two Brazilian junior and senior high school students for three months, from mid-December to mid-March, while the students are on summer vacation.
This small scale program, called Friends in the West, is a non-profit, non-church affiliated, tax exempt organization approved by the State of Idaho. It began in 1975 after a visiting Brazilian nuclear engineer and his wife spent several years in southwest Idaho at the reactor testing station. They were searching for smaller western towns in the U. S. where these Portuguese speaking Brazilian students would be able to practice and improve their English and gain the experience of close family ties in wholesome environments. All have studied English but the degree of proficiency varies from poor to excellent.
This is a two-way program and several dozen American youths have had experience with Brazilian families during their summer vacation. Students from Latah County will be eligible to apply for three month tours to Brazil.
Moscow and Deary have hosted a total of five students in this program over the last three years. The Brazilian students pay all their expenses, including spending money, ski trips and admission expenses, and host families are expected to provide friendship, room and board.

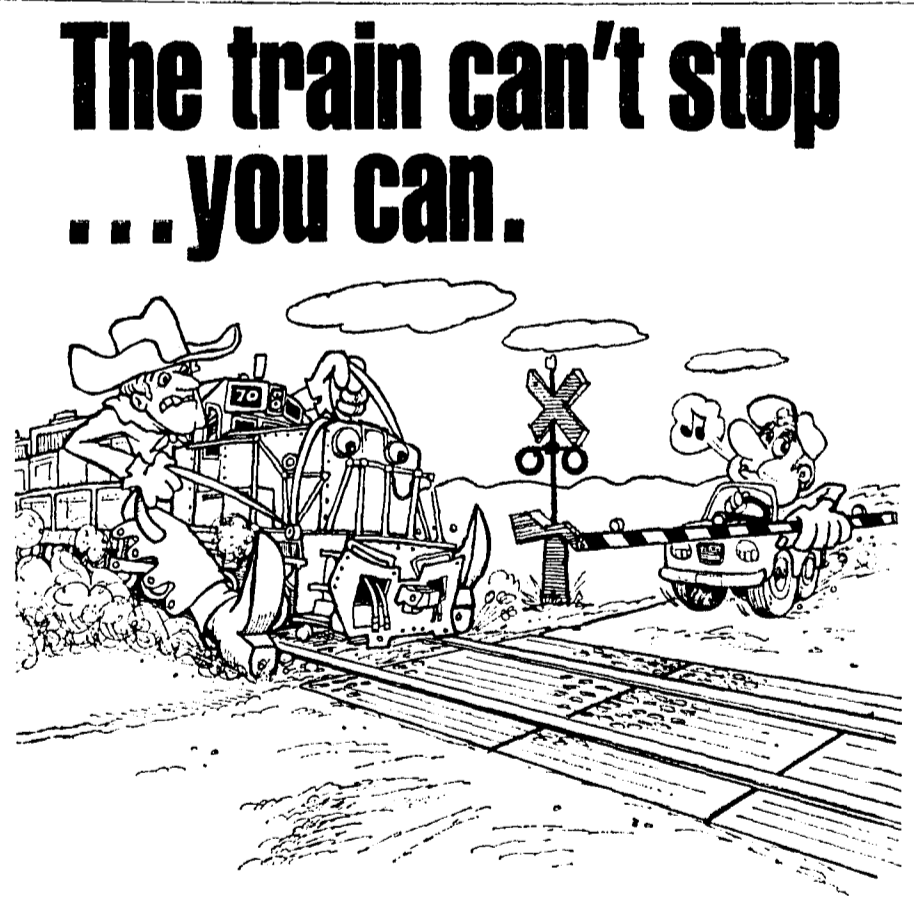
