FISH & GAME TO RUN HUNTER CHECK STATIONS

Lewiston—The Idaho Department of Fish and Game announced recently that it will conduct hunter check stations this fall as in previously hunting seasons. The type most likely to be encountered by hunters is the game management check station. These will be set up in three locations: one near Orofino on the Grangemont Road, a second at Kooskia on Highway 12 and a third at Lolo Pass, also on Highway 12.

The chief purpose of these stations is to collect biological data on the animal's harvested. Wildlife managers will use this information in setting future hunting seasons, controlled hunts and bag limits. The stations also provide convenient check-in-points for hunters who harvest those big game species for which mandatory reports are specified.

The Kooskia and Lolo Pass check stations will be open September 15 through October 28. The Orofino station will be open October 3 through October 28. All sportsmen returning from hunting or fishing are required by law to stop at one of these stations, whether or not they have game or fish, if it lies within the return route from the field.

Enforcement of fish and game laws is the chief purpose of another type of check station also to be conducted this hunting season. Department conservation officers may run a one-day check station on a major thoroughfare such as Highway 95 or 12. All vehicles will be required to stop. Hunters and fishermen will be routed aside for some brief questions and a check of any game or fish.

Impromptu check stations, also for the purpose of enforcing fish and game laws, may be conducted on

secondary and back roads, day or night for a period of two to six hours. All vehicles will be required to stop at these stations as well.

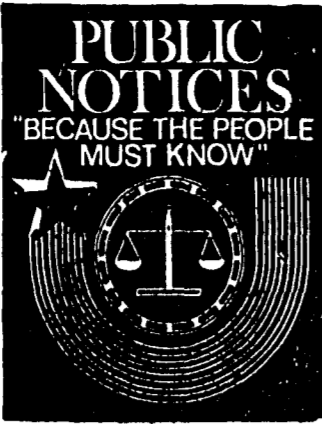
