

## Legal Notices

### SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 259

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR WATER SERVICE BY THE CITY OF JULIAETTA, IDAHO; PRESCRIBING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONDUCT AND OPERATION OF THE WATER SYSTEM OF SAID CITY AND CONNECTION THEREWITH; REGULATING AND GOVERNING THE USE OF WATER FROM SAID SYSTEM; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NONPAYMENT OF WATER SERVICE AND FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance provides rules and regulations for the operation of the Juliaetta Water System and includes: general terms; the service area; a description of services; application of service procedure; policy on extension of mains; policies regarding meters; that water rates may be adopted by resolution; policy on notices to customers, billings and payment, procedures for discontinuance of service and restoration of service; provisions for access to property, responsibilities for equipment; policy for fire hydrants; penalties (misdemeanor fine of up to \$300, 30 days in jail, or both); and provides that this Ordinance shall be effective upon publication of this Summary.

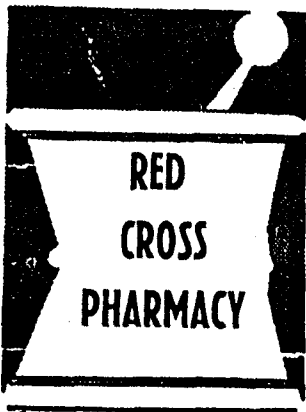
