**Legal Notice**

**ORDINANCE NO. 663**

This City of Kendrick has passed Ordinance No. 663 on the 30th day of May, 1996 descriptively entitled the City of Kendrick 1996 Water and Sewer Revenue Bond Ordinance (the "Ordinance"). The Ordinance relates to the water and sewer system of the City of Kendrick, Idaho and the issuance of the City's Water and Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series 1996 and in summary the Ordinance provides: definition of terms; authorization of the City to issue bonds in the principal amount of \$500,000 to be payable as to principal and interest solely from the net revenues of the City Water and sewer system; a description of the bonds indicating that they will be in the denomination of \$5,000 bearing interest at the rates set forth in the Ordinance, for semi-annual payment of the principal and interest on the bond on May 15 and November 15 of each year with the first payment due November 15, 1996; permitting early redemption of the bonds maturing on or after November 15, 2007; for bond registration, appointing First Security Bank of Idaho, N. A., as bond registrar, paying agent, escrow agent and transfer agent; that the City and its officers shall treat the person in whose name any bond is registered

as the owner thereof; sets forth the procedure for the execution of the bonds; provides that the bonds shall be issued pursuant to the Revenue Bond Act; that the principal and interest on bonds shall be payable solely out of the net income of the water and sewer system, that the facility to be acquired with the bond proceeds will be useful for at least thirty (30) years or until June 1, 2026; for the bond preparation, execution and delivery; for creation of the Capital Improvement Fund into which all proceeds of the Bond shall be deposited; that the system shall be operated upon a fiscal year commencing October 1 in each year and ending September 30 of the following year; for the creation of a special fund and account known of the "Income Fund" into which all revenues of the water and sewer system shall be deposited; sets forth the procedures for the general administration of funds in the "Income Fund", the "1996 Water and Sewer Revenue Bond Fund" and the "1996 Water and Sewer Revenue Bond Debt Service Reserve Fund", the general administration of such funds; that the bonds constitute an irrevocable lien up the net revenues of the water and sewer system; the procedure for issuing additional bonds; the privilege of and procedure for refunding any outstanding bonds constituting a lien on water and sewer system revenues; for protective covenants that the City agrees to with each and every holder, including, but not limited to, the use of bond proceeds, payment of bonds, authorizing use charges, levy of charges, efficient operations, record keeping, inspection rights of the purchaser, audits and budgeting requirements, billing procedures, use of bonds and reserve funds, charges and liens upon the system, construction contract and the bonding and insurance requirements to be provided by the City, requiring the City not to grant a franchise or license to any competing water or sewer systems within the City, providing the City shall not be allowed to sell or otherwise alienate the water and sewer system of the City, requiring the City not to extend or be a party to the extension of time for paying any claim for interest, obligating the City with regard to management of the system, and requiring the City to provide a surety bond for the City Treasurer covering the receiving and maintaining of the accounts of the system, stating the City's intent to comply with its agreements, and requiring the City to maintain its corporate identity; for a non-arbitrage clause; for a limitation on the issuance of bonds not to exceed \$5,000,000.00; setting forth that the bonds herein described are qualified tax-exempt obligations; for the events of and remedies for default; providing for the City's duties upon default; requires that rates for use of the system be set at a level which will produce revenues of the System less operations and maintenance expenses sufficient to pay 125% of the maximum annual principal and interest on the bonds; sets forth the obligation that the bonds are a prior charge on revenues of the system in the event any commission or authority lawfully prescribes a lower schedule of rates than contemplated by this Ordinance; the procedure for amending the Ordinance; that the Ordinance is irrevocable, a severability clause, a repealer clause and the requirement of publication; setting forth that the Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
