Sharon said. "Your cooperation helps keep our carriers safe and also helps provide more efficient mail delivery."

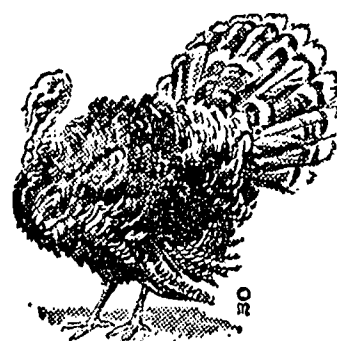
