#### Is Your Home Healthy?

We want our homes to provide shelter from the elements and to be a place of comfort and refuge from the outside world. Yet it's important to know that home may also become an unhealthy environment for you and your loved ones.

"If people go too far when trying to shut off their home from outside elements, they can actually make it an unhealthy place," says Dr. Jane Koenig, professor of environmental

health at the University of Washington School of Public Health and Community Medicine. "We know dust mites, mold and pets aren't increasing that much but people's exposure to them is increasing as they tighten up their homes."

Poor air quality, dust and mold which may develop in homes can contribute to asthma, allergies and maladies related to "sick building syndrome," such as headaches and nose, throat, eye and skin problems. These irritants can greatly increase during the winter months, when many people take measures to seal their homes from the cold.

So, while a warm, cozy house may feel inviting, Koenig suggest that homeowners keep in mind the overall health of their home environment and offers some warning signs to be aware of.

♦ Steamed-up windows—This is a sign of dampness which often provides an ideal breeding

ground for mold. Foggy windows in the bathroom can be remedied by installing a fan or keeping a window slightly open to improve air flow. In the kitchen area, Koenig suggests turning on stove fans when boiling foods. Low frequency pulses made by blue whales when communicating with each other have been measured at 188 decibels, making them the loudest sounds emitted by any living source.
