**Be Merry, Not Stressed
 This Holiday Season**

By taking some time to step back, relax and rethink your plans for the coming days, you can help make the holidays more enjoyable and memorable for the entire family. Weisman offers the following tips to help make the holidays more enjoyable and stress free:

Make Priorities—Instead of trying to do it all, make a list of what you can realistically achieve placing priorities on things you enjoy the most. If thoughts of spending your holiday in the kitchen baking treats and preparing a festive dinner are unappealing, opt to scale down on your baking; instead, plan a potluck and focus on spending time with family and friends.

Establish new traditions—If holiday traditions have lost their excitement, try starting new ones. "Traditions can be changed and simplified," Weisman says. "Allowing children and others to add to Christmas traditions can make family

time more enjoyable for everyone." Rethink gift giving—Gifts don't have to be expensive to be special. Instead of fretting about finding the "perfect" gift or spending more money than your resources allow, spend time thinking of gifts you know will be enjoyed. Homemade gifts or second-hand treasures from thrift stores are creative and enjoyable alternatives to expensive gift giving.

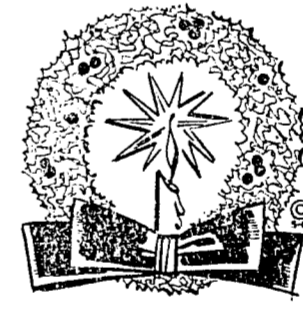
